## STAR FLEET BATTLE FORCE


Recently, Dan Dowling wrote in to ask if we could do a battleship card for *Star Fleet Battle Force*, and we thought that this was a great idea. So, Dan, these battleships are just for you!

There are no special rules for these ships, although you might note that we gave them four "free hits" above what might have been expected, just to reflect the toughness of these massive warships. The total of a ship is, so often, greater than the sum of their parts, and these 350-BPV monstrosities are, indeed, more than just two battlecruisers stuck together.

We left out the fighters, since they just complicated the rules and, well, these things didn't need them anyway. We also gave the Federation *Mars*-class battleship a battery of phaser-3s instead of explaining the special rules for the phaser-Gs on the SSD from *Star Fleet Battles*. More than a few *SFB* players think that battleships should not have had fighters or ph-Gs anyway.


